CONFESSION OF FAITH: NICENE CREED

We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible. 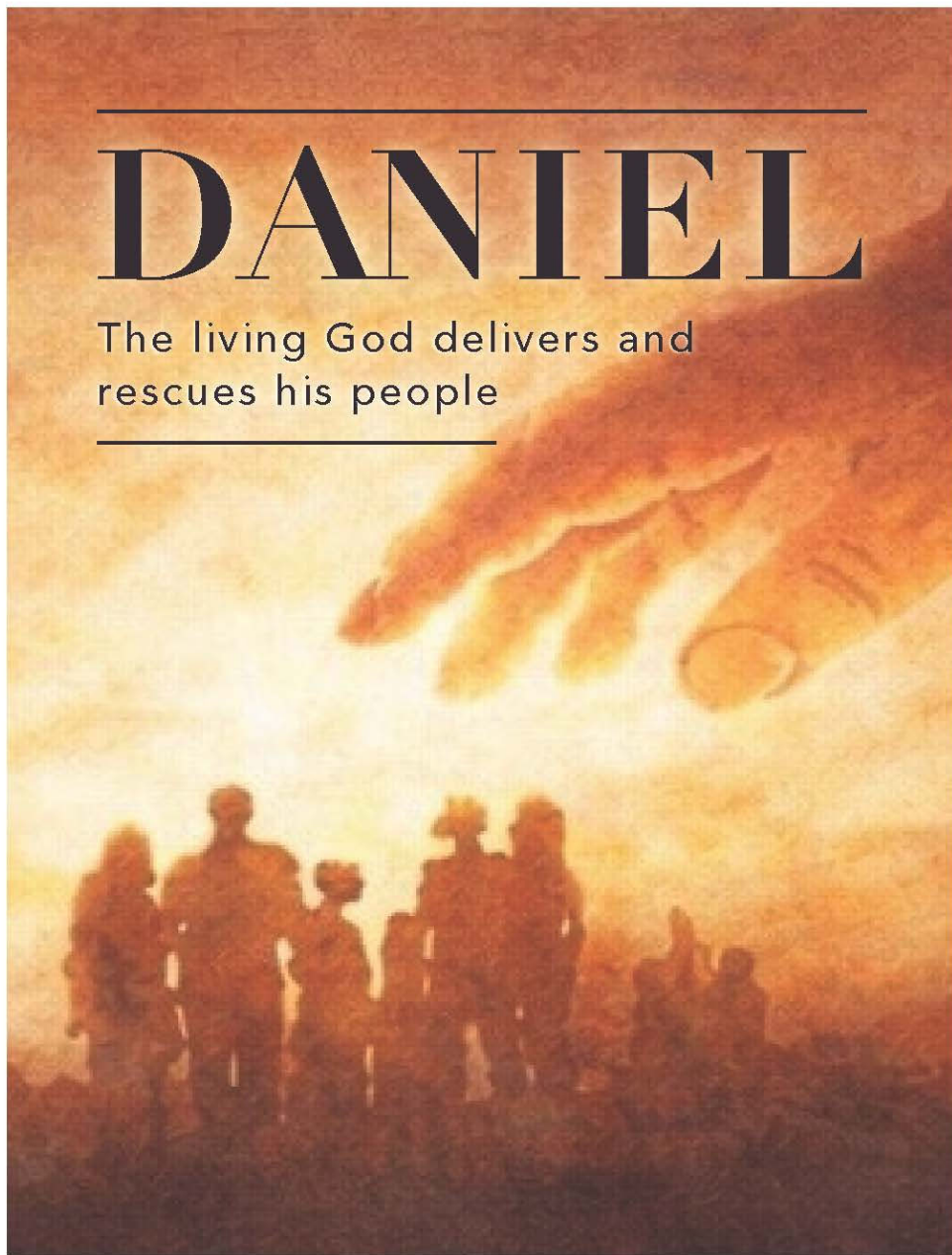
