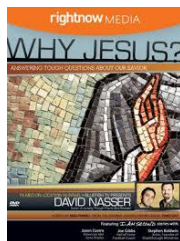

Theme: **The Holy Spirit**



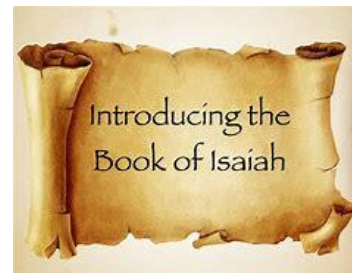

Theme: **Isaiah**



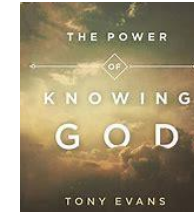
